

Beaded Row Counter Bracelet

Workshop Description



*Make your own Beaded Row Counter Bracelet -
with coordinating Stitch Markers - great for gifts!*

Skill Level: Beginner.

Description: Learn how to keep track of your rows (knitters & crocheters) using a method that dates back thousands of years and make a decorative bracelet to do it. The Beaded Row Counter Bracelet created in this workshop uses the same counting method as an abacus!

In this workshop, you will make a beaded row counter bracelet that fits your wrist using your selections from the hundreds of beads we have available for you, with a special bead to mark the starting end of your bracelet and two handy coordinating stitch markers in case you need to catch that dropped stitch or mark the beginning of the round.

The workshop will cover how to make the bracelet and also how to use it as well.

Additional bead sets and supplies will be available for purchase if you would like to make additional bracelets. Tools will be provided for your use during the workshop.

Fee: **\$30.00 (includes materials).** You may purchase additional sets of materials to make as many bracelets as you want. These are not “pre-made” kits but combinations of beads and wires that



you select. We have approximately 40 different styles of primary beads and many more small beads for spacers.

Materials List: Everything needed for the workshop will be provided. If you already own any beading pliers, you may use them. If you do not own any, do not purchase any for the class. You will want to try the different types of pliers we will have available to see which ones work best for you.
