

Crochet Essentials 102 - Crochet in the Round

Class Description and Materials List

Skill level: Beginner

Skills Taught in this Class: Joining
Rounds; Spiral Rounds

Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class, or prior to any class session; registered students receive a 10% discount on all class tools and materials. While the store is open for last-minute purchases prior to each class session, we ask that you purchase your yarn before the first class meeting date so that any hank yarns can be wound into balls for your use at the beginning of the first class.

Class Description: This class will cover techniques for crocheting in the round, making a hat to develop and practice these techniques. Students will learn how to make a hat using joined rounds or spiral rounds, how to change colors, and how to use a magic ring to start a project.



Class Samples and sizing information: Size 22 inch circumference sample hats were crocheted using a worsted weight yarn and aa sock or fingering weight yarn (crocheted double stranded to achieve a weight comparable to worsted weight).



Materials List: (Pattern will be distributed at the first class meeting.)

Yarn: 1 100 gm skein of any worsted weight yarn. For a summery hat, chose a yarn such as Cascade Sunseeker, Classic Elite Cricket, elsebeth lavold Hempathy, or Universal Yarns Cotton Supreme. For a wintery hat, choose a wool or alpaca blend. While a sock weight yarn may be used, double stranded, this is sometimes difficult for beginners.

Crochet Hook: Size H8 (5mm)

Tools: Stitch marker (split-ring type for crochet), tapestry/darning needle, or smaller crochet hook (to work in loose ends and for seaming), scissors, pencil, magnet board or highlighter to mark your place in the pattern (may use sticky notes).
