

Crochet Essentials 103 - The Granny Square Afghan

Class Description and Materials List

Skill Level: Beginner

Skills Taught in this Class: How to turn corners, Change colors, Reading a basic pattern

Prerequisite Skills: Chain, Double Crochet

Description: In this class, participants will learn how to make a basic granny square and take it to the next level, to make an afghan. Participants will learn how to make a traditional square and also a rectangle, suitable to a lap blanket. The basic techniques learned in this class are also the basis for all Granny Square patterns.

Class Sample: Pictured: Stroller Blanket – Classic Elite Yarns Sprout; 3 skeins Candytuft, 1 skein Summer Cloud.

Materials List:

- **Yarn:** Any bulky yarn or worsted weight yarn of your choice. Beginners may find bulky yarns easier to work with. If you would like to make a blanket or afghan, we recommend that you purchase a machine washable wool blend yarn. The shop staff can assist you in determining how much yarn you will need for your finished project, depending on the size you would like it to be.

- **Needles:** Crochet Hook – size recommended on selected yarn
- **Tools:** Scissors and pen & paper to take notes
