

## Crochet Essentials 202 - Crocheting a Triangle

### Class Description and Materials List

**Skill Level:** Advanced beginner

**Skills Taught:** Magic Ring, Shaping a triangular shawl using symmetrical increases, Chart Reading.

**Prerequisite Skills:** Chain, Single Crochet, Double Crochet, HalfDoubleCrochet

**Location/Date/Time:** Yarn Expressions; **Sunday (s) January 27<sup>th</sup>, February 3<sup>rd</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>, from 4 to 530pm.**

**Fee:** **\$50.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class, or prior to any class session; registered students receive a 10% discount on all class tools and materials. While the store is open for last-minute purchases prior to each class session, we ask that you purchase your yarn before the first class meeting date so that any hank yarns can be wound into balls for your use at the beginning of the first class.

**Class Description:** This class will review fundamental skills needed to construct a triangle shawl. The class project, the Morning Meadow Shawl, begins with a magic ring and then builds using increases in the center and on each side. This creates the triangle shape. Basic stitches are utilized in making the shawl. We will also cover reading crochet charts.

**Class Sample** was knitted from Manos Wool Clasica which is a bulky yarn.

**Materials List: (Pattern will be distributed at the first class meeting.)**

**Yarn:** The pattern calls for 750 yards of worsted weight yarn. This will create a lighter drapier version of the shawl.

**Needles/Hooks:** Crochet hooks: 6.00 mm (J/10). If you crochet tight, you will want to go up at least one or two sizes of hook. When creating lacy designs, you



want to create a loose drapery fabric that can be blocked severely to show the lace pattern.

**Tools:** Tapestry/darning needle, or smaller crochet hook (to work in loose ends), scissors, pencil, magnet board or highlighter to mark your place in the pattern (may use sticky notes); Locking Stitch Markers.

**Yarn suggestions:** Universal Yarns Poems and Poems Silk for variegated colorways . Berroco Lustra for a solid color version of this shawl. For a machine washable

practical shawl, Universal Yarns Classic Shades or Berroco Vintage are also good choices.
