

Crochet Essentials 101: Spring/Summer Shrug

Class Description and Materials List



Description:

This three session class will introduce and develop the fundamental crochet skills.

Skill level: Beginner; no experience required

Prerequisite skills needed: N/A

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions;

Fee: \$65.00 plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class, or prior to any class session; registered students receive a 10% discount on all class tools and materials. We ask that you purchase your yarn before the first class meeting date so that any hank yarns can be wound into balls for your use at the beginning of the first class.

Class Sample and sizing information:

Sample was made using 2 skeins of Encore Worsted Weight, color 0235. Encore is a wool blend yarn that is a good starter yarn for a first project.

One size fits most; any needed size adjustments will be taught.

Gauge is not essential, but if you make a MUCH larger shrug, more yarn will be required.



Materials List: (Pattern will be distributed at the first class meeting.)

Yarn: 2 skeins (400 yards) Worsted Weight yarn (see suggestions below).

Crochet hooks: 8 mm (L); 9 mm (M) hook is recommended for starting chain

Gauge: N/A

Tools: Darning needle, scissors, note-taking materials.

Yarn suggestions: Andrea recommends Encore for your first project. If you would prefer not to use a wool blend, Berocco Comfort is another good basic yarn. Any worsted weight yarn in the shop will work with the pattern and we encourage you to experiment with our other yarns once you have mastered the basic skills taught in this class. Softer yarns will have more drape; yarns with cotton, silk, rayon and artificial fibers will typically be cooler for summer.

Yarn Expressions Class Policies

All class fees are non-refundable! Please understand we are securing an instructor's time and holding a place just for you.

We offer classes for all skill levels, but not every class is designed for every level.
