



Crocheted Wingspan Shawl

Class Description and Materials List

Skill level: *Advanced Beginner*

Skills Taught: Crocheted short rows; shaping techniques; changing colors.

Prerequisite Skills: Chain, slip stitch, single crochet.

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; **Saturdays, September 14th, 21st and October 5th** from 930 to 1130am. (Please note – a week is skipped between the second and third sessions to allow

participants adequate time to make their shawl as large as they would like and still complete the project by the end of the class.)

Fee: **\$65.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class, or prior to any class session; registered students receive a **10% discount** on all class tools and materials. While the store is open for last-minute purchases prior to each class session, we ask that you purchase your yarn before the first class meeting date so that any hank yarns can be wound into balls for your use at the beginning of the first class.

Class Sample: Made using happiest girl! dyeworks Gloss sock yarn and Cascade Heritage Silk Sock Yarn.

Materials List: *(Pattern will be distributed at the first class meeting.)*

Yarn: 2 skeins (200gms total) Sock / Fingering weight yarn. 800 to 900 yards: this quantity makes the largest version of the pattern as shown.

Crochet hook: 3.5 mm (E/4)

Tools: Tapestry/darning needle, or smaller crochet hook (to work in loose ends and for seaming), scissors, pencil, magnet board or highlighter to mark your place in the pattern (may use sticky notes).

Yarn suggestions: Two 100 gm skeins of different sock / fingering weight yarns in different colors or one sock / fingering weight yarn in two different colors
