Knitting Essentials 101

Class Description and Materials List

Take the first steps to become an accomplished knitter

Skill Level: Absolute Beginner.

Skills Taught in Class: knit, purl, cast-on, bind-off, basic

pattern reading, mattress stitch, and fixing common mistakes, decrease stitches

Prerequisite Skills: None

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; 3 session class, Mondays, February 10th, 17th and 24th, 530 – 730pm.

Fee: \$65.00 plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class or any time prior to the first class session. Registered students receive a 10% discount on all class tools and materials. While the store will open a few minutes prior to each class session, please keep last minute purchases to a minimum so the class can start on time.

Description: A contemporary stocking cap, topped with a pompom, this season's most popular trend, is a great first project. The hat pattern will help you learn how to cast-on; knit and purl; follow a pattern; and how recognize common knitting mistakes and how to correct them before you have gone too far. You will even learn how to make a pompom or you can purchase a cute funky one at Yarn Expressions.

Materials List: (Pattern will be distributed at first class)

Yarn: approximately 220 yards of a **light colored** worsted weight yarn. Good yarns for this pattern include: Cascade 220, Berroco Vintage; Poems; UYI worsted; Noro Kureyon; or any other worsted weight yarn. Berroco Comfort is **not** a good choice for this project. All of the listed yarns, as well as others that are available at Yarn Expressions. Only one color yarn will be used for this project.

Needles: size 7 circular or straight needles.

Gauge: NA

Tools: Blunt tapestry needle; scissors or snips; and pen & paper to take notes.
