

Knitted Snowflakes

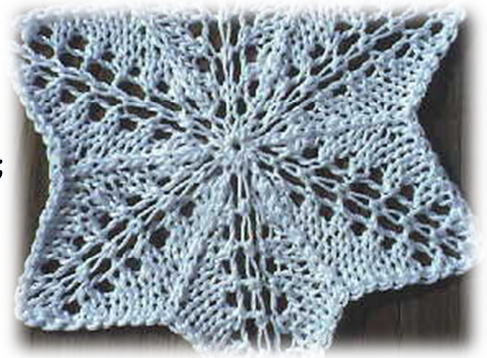
Workshop Description and Materials List

Skill Level: *Intermediate to Advanced.*

Skills Taught: Center-Start Cast-On, Center Double Decrease.

Prerequisite Skills: Knit, purl, increases, decreases, cast-ons, bind-offs; prior experience with knitting in the round and/or working with dpn's is helpful.

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; single 2 hour session, Wednesday, **November 28th** from 530 -730pm.



Fee: **\$30.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class or any time prior to the workshop. Registered students receive a **10 percent discount** on all class tools and materials.

Instructor: Diane Lyles

Description: You will knit a snowflake ornament; using a fool proof cast-on for a beautiful center. Several more advanced patterns are available for the more adventurous experienced knitters. Beginning Knitters: if you would like to create a holiday trivet or a giant snowflake washcloth using heavier yarns and larger needles, you are welcome to sign up for this class.

Materials List: *(Pattern will be distributed at the class meeting)*

Yarn: For standard snowflake ornament, you will need Crochet Cotton. One ball will make multiple snowflakes.

If you prefer to knit a trivet or something else larger, you may use any cotton or wool or blend worsted or heavier weight yarn.

Needles: Size 2 double-point needles (dpns) for the basic pattern; Size 1 dpns for the more advanced patterns. If you are choosing to knit a larger version of the snowflake, you will need needles appropriate for your selected yarn. A selection of recommended dpns is available at the shop checkout. Crochet hook similar in size to your needles; Tapestry needle.

Gauge: NA.
