

Lace Infinity Scarf Class

Advance your lace knitting skills while making this stunning infinity scarf.

Skill Level: Intermediate

Skills Taught in Class: Provisional cast-on, grafting in garter stitch, reading charts, inserting a lifeline, and a new technique for left leaning decreases!

Prerequisite Skills: simple increases and decreases in addition to basic knitting skills

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; **Tuesday, March 19th 5:00 to 8:00pm and Monday, April 22nd 5:00 to 8:00pm**

Fee: **\$65.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class or any time **prior to the first class session**. Registered students receive a **10 percent** discount on all class tools and materials.

Description: During the first session students will learn the crochet provisional cast-on, practice reading charted lace, learn a new technique for left leaning decreases, and learn how to insert a lifeline. Then we head home to practice, practice, practice! The second session will consist of learning to remount the provisional stitches and graft the two ends together in garter stitch.



Materials Required:

- 400-450 yards of fingering weight yarn containing some silk, bamboo, viscose. Sample scarf was knit with Knit One Crochet Too Crock-O-Dye.
- One 16-24" Circular Needle US Size #6 (4.0mm). Sharp tips are highly recommended!
- One crochet hook size F(3.75mm) or G(4.00mm) for provisional cast on.
- Stitch Markers (optional)
- Row Counter (optional)
- Small, Blunt Tapestry needle
- Pattern will be provided
