

Marble Mosaic Mobius/Cowl

Class Description and Materials List

Skill level: Advanced Beginner; participants should be familiar with basic stitches.

Prerequisite Skills: Chain, single crochet, double crochet.

Description: This one session class will build on fundamental skills. In addition to using basic stitches, you will learn joining for either a cowl or mobius, various spike stitches, and reading a crochet chart. The class project will give you practice in all these stitches and prepare you for more advanced projects.

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; **Saturday December 1st; 3:30 to 6:30pm**

Fee: **\$35.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class, or prior to any class session; registered students receive a 10% discount on all class tools and materials. While the store will be open for last-minute purchases prior to each class session, we ask that you purchase your yarn before the first class meeting date so that any hank yarns can be wound into balls for your use at the beginning of the first class.

Class Sample and sizing info:
Circumference 68", width 6 ½".
Gauge swatch will not be necessary.

Materials List: (Pattern will be distributed at the first class meeting.)

Yarn: James Brett Marble Chunky in your choice of color (1 skein).

Crochet Hook: Size J/6mm. If you crochet very tightly, you may want to go up to a 6.5mm hook, if you crochet loosely, you may want to use a 5.5mm hook.

Tools: Stitch marker (split-ring type for crochet), one "safety pin" type marker, which will be provided by instructor), tapestry/darning needle, or smaller crochet hook (to work in loose ends), scissors, pencil, magnet board or highlighter tape to mark your place in the pattern (sticky notes can be used).

Alternate Yarn suggestions: Other chunky weight yarns may be used. Two nice options are Cascade Covington, which is a wool and acrylic blend, or Crystal Palace Mochi Plus, a merino nylon blend.
