

## Oops! Now What?

*Don't start over! Learn how to identify and fix mistakes in your knitting.*

**Skill Level:** Beginner Knitters

**Prerequisite Skills:** Casting on, Knitting and Purling

**Skills Taught in Class:** Un-knitting (tinking), Ripping back (frogging), properly remounting stitches onto the needle, fixing dropped stitches, adding a life-line.

**Location/Date/Time:** Yarn Expressions;  
**January 28<sup>th</sup>; 5:00 to 8:00pm**

**Fee:** **\$35.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class or any time **prior to the first class session**. Registered students receive a **10 percent** discount on all class tools and materials.

**Description:** Students will learn to identify and repair numerous basic mistakes on swatches prepared before class.

### **Materials Required:**

- Approximately 50 yards of a smooth, light colored, **worsted weight** yarn (try to choose a high quality yarn that doesn't split) divided into two separate balls
- Two sets of knitting needles size US7 and/or US8
- A small, blunt, metal tapestry needle
- One crochet hook size C (2.75mm) or D (3.00 mm) or a Seed Stitcher
- Coiless Safety Pins
- A small (US3 or smaller) circular knitting needle (If you don't have anything this size, I recommend a 32" US2)

### **Class Homework:**

- Using one set of US7 or US8 needles and one ball of worsted weight yarn, cast on 20 stitches and work 15 to 20 rows of stockinette stitch (knit one row, purl one row, etc). Leave the knitting on the needles and do not break the yarn.



- Using the remaining set of US7 or US8 needles and the other ball of worsted weight yarn, cast on 20 stitches and work 15 to 20 rows of garter stitch (knit one every row). Leave the knitting on the needles and do not break the yarn.
