Description: During this 3-hour session, students will learn the color technique of tapestry crochet including how to make flawless color changes.

Materials Required:

- Approximately 40 yards of DK Weight 100% Cotton Yarn in two colors (80 yards total)
 (Sample was worked in Berroco Pure Pima)
- One Size C (2.5mm or 2.75mm) crochet hook
- One removable stitch marker
- Tapestry needle to weave in ends
