

Sanibel Circular Shawl

Class Description and Materials List

Skill level: Advanced beginner.

Skills Taught in Class: How to do Treble crochet, make Shells and clusters.

Prerequisite Skills: Chain, slip stitch, single crochet, double crochet. Experience with crocheting in the round is recommended but not mandatory. Your project will go much quicker if you already know how to crochet in the round but the process will be reviewed for participants who need it.

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions: **Saturdays, May 10th, 24th and June 7th** (one week skipped between sessions to allow students to get more of their shawl completed); **9 to 11am.**



Fee: **\$65.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class, or prior to any class session; registered students receive a **10% discount** on all class tools and materials.

Description: This class will review fundamental skills needed to construct a circular shawl. The class project, the Sanibel Circular Shawl, uses a circular baby afghan pattern that combines with the yarn to make a wonderful lacy summer shawl.

Materials Required:

Yarn: 6 skeins Classic Elite Sanibel; other similar weight yarn may be substituted. We recommend

using a solid or tonal yarn to preserve the beauty of the pattern.

Pattern: Leisure Arts Book 5517; More Circular Baby Afghans

Needles/Hooks: Crochet hooks: 6.00 mm (J/10)

Tools: Crochet-specific stitch markers or scrap yarn to mark beginning of each round/pattern repeats. Tapestry/darning needle, or smaller crochet hook (to work in loose ends and for seaming), scissors, pencil, magnet board or highlighter to mark your place in the pattern (may use sticky notes).

Yarn suggestions: Other similar weight yarns may be used, but it is recommended for lightweight summery shawl to use the summertime cotton blends, linen, or similar yarns.
