

## Short Row Shawl/Scarf Class

Learn how to **knit short rows** the German way (and a button hole if you like) while creating a stunning asymmetrical shawl or scarf.

**Skill Level:** *Experienced Beginner*

**Skills Taught in Class:** Cable cast-on, German short rows, button hole.

**Prerequisite Skills:** Casting on, Binding off, Knit stitch

**Location/Date/Time:** Yarn Expressions; **April 9<sup>th</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> 5:30 to 8:00pm**

**Fee:** **\$55.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class or any time **prior to the first class session**. Registered students receive a **10 percent** discount on all class tools and materials.

**Instructor:** Diane Lyles

**Description:** During this two-session class, students will master the method of knitting German short rows while creating a unique shawl or scarf. We will also learn the cable cast-on and adding a buttonhole.

### **Materials Required:**

- 400-450 yards of fingering to sport weight yarn. Sample scarf was knit with SWTC TOFUtsies. Sample shawl was knit with handspun. Other suggested yarns are: Regia Design Line Kaffe Fassett, Schoppel-Wolle Zauberball or Crazy Zauberball, Marks & Kattens Fame Trend, Kauni Effektgarn
- One **32" Circular Needle Size #4** (3.5mm) or a size which produces a favorable garter stitch fabric using your chosen yarn. Consider going up in needle size if you are a tight knitter or are using a sport weight yarn.
- Approximately 20 yards of scrap yarn and appropriate sized needles to learn buttonhole technique.
- 8-10 pear-shaped coiless safety pins
- Row Counter (optional)
- Tapestry needle to weave in ends
