

Beaded Stitch Markers

Workshop Description



Make your own - great for gifts - coordinating/matching/large sets for shawls!

Skill Level: *Beginner.*

Description: The workshop will begin with instructions on how to choose and arrange beads for stitch marker; how to select the type and color wire; how to twist wire into eye loop and end loop ; how to trim excess wire and finish your stitch markers. A basic simple marker is the first project but students will have the opportunity to select other pattern and create designs of their choosing. Tools will be provided for your use during the workshop.

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; a single 2 hour session; **Saturday December 7th from 4 to 6pm.**

Fee: **\$35.00 includes materials.** Materials will be handled slightly differently for this workshop. A **\$5.00 materials fee** (included in your registration fee) will include as many beads and as much wire as you need to create 8 stitch markers (including one lobster claw [removeable] marker per set) using your choice of any combination of the beads and wires we have available. You may purchase additional material kits to make as many sets of stitch markers as you want. There is no discount on these kits. These are not “pre-made” kits but combinations of beads and wires that you select. You can make matching sets, or 8 completely different markers, or anything in between.

Materials List: Everything needed for the workshop will be provided. If you already own any beading pliers, you may use them. If you do not own any, do not purchase any for the class. You will want to try the different types of pliers we will have available to see which ones work best for you.
