Top-Down Sweater - Your Choice

Take the next steps in knitting - learn more about gauge, sweater construction, reading directions, and finishing

Skill Level: Very Experienced Beginner+

**Skills Taught in Class:** increases and decreases; knitting to gauge; measuring; alternate cast on and bind off; reading a pattern; and "reading" your knitting; choosing the right yarn for the right project, and lots more.

Prerequisite Skills: knit and purl, basic increasing and decreasing, cast on stitches

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; 3 session class, Saturdays; February 15th, and March 1st and 15th, from 900 - 1100 am.

**Fee: \$65.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class or any time prior to the first class session. Registered students receive a **10% discount** on all class tools and materials. While the store will open a few minutes prior to each class session, please keep last minute purchases to a minimum so the class can start on time.

## Instructor: Kirsten Muldoon

**Description:** Choose a top-down sweater pattern, or a traditional sweater pattern. A great resource is Ann Budd's book, *The Knitter's Handy Book of Top-Down Sweaters*, available at **Yarn Expressions.** Using this resource you can choose the style - cardigan, pullover, cables, raglan sleeves, yarn weight, and needle size that fits your body best. Gauge swatches will be used to make sure your project will fit properly when completed. Additionally, other types of increases and decreases will be demonstrated and practiced. This class will help increase your knitting skills and give you more confidence so you can move on to more complex projects.

**Materials List:** (Pattern will be your choice. If you need help in choosing your pattern, please visit Yarn Expressions for help, before the class)

Yarn: will be determined by your pattern choice

Needles: will be determined by your pattern choiceGauge: will be determined by your pattern choiceTools: stitch markers. Scissors or snips, and pen & paper to take notesSweater: bring a sweater that you really like!!! One that fits and flatters the best!!!

**Homework:** prior to the first session, knit a swatch using your chosen yarn and needle size indicated as indicated in your pattern.

## Swatch directions:

1. Cast on number of stitches indicated in pattern that will yield 4 inches plus 10 stitches.

2. Knit in garter stitch 5 rows

3. Knit first 5 stitches in garter stitch, knit in stockinette stitch to the last 5 stitches, knit the remaining stitches in garter stitch

4. Continue is stockinette stitch until you have knit the number of rows indicated in the pattern that will equal 4 inches

5. Knit in garter stitch for 5 rows

- 6. Bind off loosely
- 7. Block the swatch
