



Crochet Techniques 203

Class Description and Materials List

Skill Level: Intermediate

Prerequisite Skills: Chain, Single Crochet, Double Crochet, Increases and Decreases.

Location/Date/Time: **Yarn Expressions; Saturday (s)
January 26th and February 9th and 23rd from 4 to 6pm.**

This class is scheduled at two week intervals to allow participants adequate time to complete their components for assembly at the last session.

Fee: **\$65.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class, or prior to any class session; registered students receive a 10% discount on all class tools and materials. While the store will be open for last-minute purchases prior to each class session, we ask that you purchase your yarn before the first class meeting date so that any hank yarns can be wound into balls for your use at the beginning of the first class.

Class Description: This three-class series will review fundamental skills needed to construct a simple garment. The class project, a cropped trans-seasonal jacket, will give you practice in not only constructing the various pieces but also seaming them together. The class will also cover getting proper measurements, obtaining gauge, and making garments that actually fit you.

Class Sample and sizing info: Size Small constructed using Nashua Handknits Shenandoah Blue (10 skeins 980 yds). Please note that the color shifting characteristics of this yarn appear more visible in a photograph.

Materials List: (Pattern will be distributed at the first class meeting.)

Yarn: Nashua Handknits Shenandoah (Small [38" bust*] – 1,035), (Medium [43" bust+*] – 1,242), (Large



[49" bust*] – 1,449), (1X [54" bust*] – 1,656), and (2X [60" bust*] – 1,863). *This is finished bust measurements which include ease.

Needles/Hooks: Crochet hooks: 5.5 mm (I/9)

Tools: Stitch marker (split-ring type for crochet), tapestry/darning needle, or smaller crochet hook (to work in loose ends and for seaming), scissors, pencil, magnet board or highlighter to mark your place in the pattern (may use sticky notes).

Other materials: One Button

Yarn suggestions: Nashua Shenandoah. Other comparable worsted weight yarns such as the Cascade Lana Bamboo or Rustic or Berroco Lustra may be substituted.
