

Toe Up Sock Class

Learn how to cast-on and knit socks from the toe up. You can choose to knit your socks one- or two-at-a-time with one or two circular needles. Your choice based on your knitting skills!

Skill Level: Advanced Beginner to Intermediate Knitters

Skills Taught in Class: Toe-Up Cast-On, Wrap-and-Turn, Short-Row Heel, Duplicate Stitch

Prerequisite Skills: Long Tail Cast-on, Circular Knitting, Knitting and Purling, Binding off. It is helpful to have done some magic-loop knitting.

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; **February 20th, March 5th & March 19th 6 to 8pm**

Fee: **\$65.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class or any time **prior to the first class session**. Registered students receive a **10 percent discount** on all class tools and materials.

Instructor: Diane Lyles

Description: During this three-session class, students will knit totally reversible footies from the toe up. In the first session the instructor will walk you through the toe-up cast-on, setting up your knitting for your chosen method and toe increases. Students will then be set to knit the foot of the sock at home. The second session will involve knitting the short-row heel. The final session will involve knitting the cuff, binding-off and working in the ends to achieve a truly reversible sock!

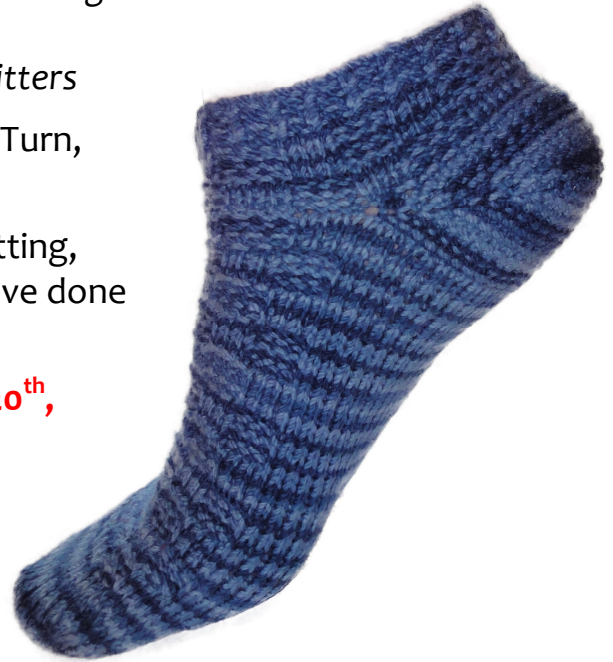
Materials List (Pattern will be provided in class):

Yarn:

- Two **50-gram balls of Cascade Fixation** yarn. This will be enough yarn to complete two pairs of socks. The instructor strongly recommends using two different colors if you are knitting your socks two-at-a-time.

Needles:

- One **32" to 40" Circular Needle Size #5** (3.75mm) if you are knitting one sock at a time or are using the magic loop method to knit two at a time.



OR

Two **24” to 32” Circular Needles Size #5** (3.75mm) if you are using the two-circular method. It is nice for these needles to be easily distinguishable (different lengths, different needle materials, different color cables, etc.)

- **One Size #8** (5.0mm) knitting needle (may be any length or type of needle) for binding off

Tools:

- Removable stitch markers or coiless safety pins
- Row Counter
- Tapestry needle to weave in ends
