

Waves Scarf Class

This easy lace scarf, also known as a Seafoam Scarf is worked forth and back. The intrigue comes from the easy-to-memorize pattern of multiple "yarn overs."

Skill Level: Beginners and up

Skills Taught in Class: Yarn overs and deliberate dropped stitches.

Prerequisite Skills: Cast on, Knit Stitch

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; **Sunday, March 17th, 4 to 6pm.**

Description: In this class you will create a scarf using yarn overs of differing lengths to create your design. The yarn overs are dropped on the following row to create the airy strands of the waves.

Fee: **\$25.00** plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class or any time **prior to the first class session.** Registered students receive a **10 percent** discount on all class tools and materials.

Materials Required (Pattern will be distributed at first class session):

- Favorite DK weight yarn such as Manos Del Uruguay Silk Blend, Malabrigio Silky Merino, Wisdom Yarns Poem Silk, Universal Yarns Classic Shades, Zen Yarn Garden Serenity 20 (all available for purchase at Yarn Expressions), 200m
- Size 7 single point or circular needles
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle for weaving in the ends
