

Weekend Jacket

Class Description and Materials List

A fast, easy, washable knit, perfect for the Alabama "winter" If you can knit, purl, and follow directions, somewhat, this is the sweater jacket for you. Knit it this September, and a little in October, and it will be ready for the first really cool days of fall. A new shipment of yarns means lots of color choices.

Skill Level: Experienced Beginner. Knit and purl independently

Skills Taught in Class: increases and decreases; alternate cast on and bind off; reading a pattern; and "reading" your knitting; and finishing techniques such as the mattress stitch.

Prerequisite Skills: Knit and purl, cast on, some experience in pattern reading

Location/Date/Time: Yarn Expressions; 3 session class, Wednesdays; September 10th, 24th, and October 15th; 530 - 730pm.

Fee: \$65.00 plus materials. Tools and materials may be purchased when you register for the class or any time prior to the first class session. Registered students receive a 10% discount on all class tools and materials. While the store will open a few minutes prior to each class session, please keep last minute purchases to a minimum so the class can start on time.

Instructor: Kirsten Muldoon

Description: "The main body of this coat is worked from side to side, which of course enables the yarn's variegations to run vertically up your body and lengthen it (as well as your legs-- wear boots!)." This is the coat that you grab as you run out the door and then toss in the backseat of the car as the temperature heats up during the day. The weekend jacket is very loose fitting, and can be closed at the neck, if desired, with a

shawl pin, or buttons. This class will help increase your knitting skills and give you more confidence so you can move on to more complex projects.

Pattern: Weekend Jacket by Sandi Prosser. This pattern is available at YE as a download from Ravelry

Yarn: The only yarn suggested for this project is James C Brett Marble Chunky.

<u>Finished Measurements:</u> <u>Skeins of Marble Chunky Needed:</u>

Bust (closed) (200g: 341 yards / 312m)

37 / 41 / 45 / 47 / 52 inches 4 / 4 / 4 / 5 / 5 balls

94 / 104 / 114.5 / 119.5 / 132 cm

Needles: size 9 (5.5mm) or size to obtain gauge if using the recommended yarn

Gauge: NA.

Tools: Stitch markers. Scissors or snips, and pen & paper to take notes
